4 Simple Ways You Can Make This Lesson Stick With your Kids

Bible Zoo Lesson 2

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE FISH

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



DRIVING:

When you catch yourself losing your temper on the road, take a moment to ask for forgiveness. Let your little ones hear you pray for help and forgiveness. Remind them that we all do wrong sometimes, but that God loves us and can forgive us if we ask.



PLAYING:

Reenact the story of Jonah and the big fish. Use dolls, action figures or play act. Talk about how God showed his love for Jonah by forgiving him when he asked for it.



EATING:

Offer up some goldfish crackers during snack time. Remind little ones of the fish in the story of Jonah. Imagine together what it must have been like in the belly of the fish. Thank God for his love and forgiveness



SNUGGLING:

In a moment of disobedience, start with a hug rather than a harsh word. Let your little one know that their disobedience doesn't change your love for them. Guide them toward a decision to ask for forgiveness. Offer forgiveness warmly and freely. Work with your little one to restore any damage caused by the disobedience.

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
