## Bible Zoo Lesson 3

### THIS WEEK'S LESSON: THE BIRDS

Use these four common times in a preschooler's day to reinforce this week's lesson:



#### DRIVING:

As you drive this week, take a moment to pray to God, thanking him for taking care of you and your family and getting you safely to each of your destinations.



#### PLAYING:

Get outside with some binoculars and go on a little bird watching expedition. What kind of birds do you see? Do you know the names of them? Afterward, go online to show your little ones what a raven – like the ones Elijah encountered – looks like. See if you can find images online of the birds you saw on your expedition.



#### EATING:

Thank God for providing your meal and thank the cook for preparing it. Talk about the unusual way that Elijah was served up his meals while in the wilderness.

#### SNUGGLING:

As you go through the bedtime routine with your little ones, talk about how each component – brushing teeth, bath, bedtime story – is a way that you try to take care of them. Remind kids you love them and want to take care of them. Let them know how much God loves and cares for them too.

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
