THIS WEEK'S LESSON: BLOWING BUBBLES



DRIVING:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:

Talk to your kids about why they have to be in a car seat, and why adults wear seat belts: It's because you care about the safety of the people in your car. We care about other people. No one cares about us more than Jesus. Even when bad times come, Jesus still cares about us and we can turn to him.



PLAYING:

Make this week's lesson real:

Get out the play kitchen and have your kids do a little "cooking." What delicacies will they be preparing for you. Talk about the fact that Jesus was able to feed over 5,000 people even without a stove or refrigerator. He had only 5 small loaves of bread and 2 fish.



EATING:

During dinner, talk about the meal that the crowd of over 5,000 had that day with Jesus. What do you think the fish and bread tasted like? Would you have been surprised that Jesus cared enough about you to feed you. Thank God for the many ways that he has taken care of you and your family.



SNUGGLING:

Snuggle up together and read the memory verse together: "So we know that God loves us. We depend on it. God is love." 1 John 4:16a. Talk about how God cares about us. When the verse says that we depend on God's love that includes us relying on God to watch over us and meet our needs.

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
